

Mezy Rosé Loire Valley



Lovely light pink color, with a fresh and fruity nose showing floral notes. A fruited palate with persistent and refreshing flavors, this wine is well-balanced, easy to drink and elegant. Delightfully aromatic and showcasing the classic structure associated with the Loire Valley, this rosé wine is perfectly suited to enjoy as an aperitif and to accompany a meal.

Palate: Strong and crisp, very fruity, fat on the finish

Food Pairing: Grilled meat, galician-style octopus, padrón pepper, paella

Serving Temperature: 6-8°C

Potential for Aging: 2 years

Vine-growing & winemaking

Grape Varieties: 100% Pinot Noir

Vinification Details: Direct pressing followed by rapid must settling.

Fermentation: Between 15 and 17°C.

Around 4 months in stainless steel vats.
