OVERVIEW

Vineyard of Château De Passedieu, created in 1986, was initially composed of 5 hectares of vines arising from the splitting up of a property once classified 1st growth in the 7th edition of Féret 1898. These 5 hectares are nowadays completed by 5 additional hectares coming from adjacent properties. Château De Passedieu, located 40 kilometres Northern Bordeaux, just a few kilometres from the commune of Bourg, is run by its owner, Mr Stéphane Février.

VINEYARD

Soil: Plots comprise ferruginous silicious-clay and "starfish" limestone-clay soils, characteristic of the Côtes de Bourg.

Surface: 10 hectares

Location: The vineyard is located on the right bank of the Gironde River facing the Médoc.

Average age of the vineyard: 40 years

Grape varieties: 75% Merlot / 15% Cabernet Sauvignon / 10% Malbec

VINIFICATION

Sorting at the vatting-house. Classical vinification. Long vatting for 28 to 30 days. Ageing on lees.

WINE TASTING

Attractive dark colour, deep and bright. The nose reveals notes of red fruits, supported by a touch of violet. The attack is frank, supple and aromatic, with hints of black cherry. Quite long and spicy finish.

MATCHING FOOD AND WINE

Serve at 17-18°C with grilled beef Prime Rib, veal sweetbread, lamb or duck dishes. This wine will be the perfect partner for terrines or a good selection of cheeses.

AGEING POTENTIAL

From 5 to 10 years
