## Grooked Path





APPELATION: Paso Robles, CA

WINEMAKING: Zinfandel and Syrah for this wine was yieled from out Estate Vineyard in the El Pomer District of Paso Robles. Additionally, Petite Sirah from Chalk Knoll Vineyards in San Ardo, Monterey Country rounds out the blend. The wine was aged for 22 monthes in oak barrels. 10% new American oak and 10% new Hungarian oak.

TASTING NOTES: Dark in color with an intense nose this Zinfandel is equal parts brooding and approachable. At it's core this wine explodes with ripe blackberry and juicy raspberry. Rich on the palate with white pepper spice and darks fruits yet elegant with refined tannins this wine carris to a lingering finish highlighted by the sweet vanilla character of fine oak.
