SOIL

From the hillsides of the Sèvre river to those of the Loire, from the doors of this beautiful city of Nantes to the confine of the Vendée county, the AC Muscadet draws its wealth from a ground composed grounds mixed with eruptive rocks.

CLIMATE

The Muscadet vineyard, the western one and the closest to the Atlantic Ocean, is certainly the vastest white vineyard of France.

The vine plants are planted on series of sunny slopes which rarely overtop 50 metres. Those slopes are generally facing South-West. They are exposed to oceanic influences and are placed side by side with the pink laurels and parasol pines.

HARVEST

Sticker regulations on production per acre enable us to produce wonderful Muscadet on the Sèvre et Maine appellation areas. We can now use the grapes we harvested near to our ultra-modern vinification centre. This method is a real success: AC Muscadet are fine, fruity and powerful. Volumes then produced go on developing.
