# Irish whiskey is the fastest growing spirit in the US \*



This globally awarded, lively single grain whiskey is first aged in Bourbon barrels then finished in Spanish Oloroso barrels. 3 years in aligator-charred American oak lays that beautifully smooth foundation of vanilla, honey, caramel flavors. The Oloroso barrels make it more complex and rounded adding dried fruit, raisins and almond flavors. The heavy tannins and woody spices of Spanish oak make this the whiskey equivalent of an old head on young shoulders in terms of taste.



After 7 years in a bourbon cask, this whiskey then goes into craft porter casks. Made with a heavily roasted barley called chocolate malt, the porter changes the cask, bringing incredible depths of flavor to the whiskey. It starts with vanilla and citrus notes but soon gives way to creme brulee and darker flavors like toffee, cocoa and even coffee on the finish. This whiskey is a nod to the 7 years St Kevin spent in the wild and the city of 7 churches he built at Glendalough (7 silver crosses on the label map their position).



The first, and only, Irish Whiskey to use the rare and legendary Japanese Mizunara oak. This whiskey was already winner of "Best Irish whiskey" at the San Francisco World Spirits Competition, but these rare casks have made this world-beating single malt even better. A unique flavor profile that whiskey drinkers love, it is a dramatic shift in what is being done with Irish Whiskey. Vanilla from 13 years in the bourbon casks has been amplified while mango, marmalade, sandalwood and oriental spices take you on an unexpected journey.



## IRISH MULE

2 oz	Double Barrel
1/2 oz	Fresh Lime Juice
4 oz	Jamaican Ginger Beer
3 dashes	Angostura bitters
Garnish	Lime wheel
Tools	Barspoon
Glass	Hightball

Pour the whiskey and lime juice into an ice-filled glass. Add the ginger beer, stir, then bitters on top and garnish with lime wheel.



## BOULEVARDIER

1 1/2 oz	Double Barrel
1 oz	Campari
1 oz	Sweet Vermouth
Garnish	Orange slice, lemon twist or cherry
Tools	Mixing glass, barspoon and strainer
Glass	Old Fashioned

Stir ingredients well with ice in a mixing glass and strain into a chilled glass with ice. Garnish.

A small team who believed that independent, small-batch, Irish whiskey could make a comeback. They left the safety of their city jobs to make something more meaningful in the mountains - much like the man on their bottle, St Kevin. Together they built Ireland's first craft distillery near their favorite spot in those mountains, GLENDALOUGH.
