DOC Douro Wine

From the best grapes sourced from the company's two estates in Douro Superior and Ervedosa do Douro, vinified at Quinta das Quartas (Régua), this wine intends to materialize the philosophy of its name: to be a Símbolo (the Portuguese word for symbol) of its origin.

SUB-REGION	Ervedosa do Douro (Cima Corgo); Numão (Douro Superior)
GRAPE VARIETIES	Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca
VINE'S AGE	40-60 Years
TYPE OF SOIL	Schist
HARVEST	Grapes are harvested manually and transported in 30 Kg trays.
VINIFICATION	Temperature controlled fermentation with pumping over and extended maceration.
AGING	Matures in new American oak and French "Allier" oak casks (300 Litres) for 18 months, followed by a fining period in stainless steel vats until bottling date.

TASTING NOTES

COLOR	Full red.
AROMA	Rich and lovely balanced, dry cherries, chocolate and a touch of tobacco.
PALATE	Marvellous complexity and depth, extraordinary balance, ripe tannins and a lasting finish.
