



JMM TERRAS DA RIBEIRA RED WINE

Quality: Wine

Type: Red

Grapes: blend of several portuguese grape varieties such as Baga, Touriga-Nacional, Jaen, Castelão

Winemaker: António Narciso



Organoleptic notes: Young wine with vivid fruit, garnet color, hints of spices. On the palate is soft with harmonious finish.

Soil: Soils are manly sand, clay and loamy sand. Vine grows manly on clay and limestone soils. The name Bairrada is from “barro” the portuguese word for clay.

Climate: climate is characterized as “Mediterranean – Atlantic”. Winters are Chilly, whereas summers are milder on account of west and north-west winds common in regions closer to the sea.

Type of fermentation vats: Inox

Suggestions: wine for rapid consumption, ideal for light dishes, serving temperature of 16 to 18^aC.

Contains sulfites
