

THE WATER FROM THE MOUNTAIN DEPOSITED VARIOUS MINERALS AND COMPOUNDS IN THE SOILS OF ALTAMIRA. OVER A VERY SHORT DISTANCE, THE SOIL COMPOSITION VARIES WITH THE PRESENCE OF SAND, SILT, STONE AND CALCIUM CARBONATE. MALBEC FROM ALTAMIRA TEND TO SHOW EARTHY PROFILES PROVIDING SOMETHING UNIQUE TO A BLEND.




ALTO AGRELO: 1100 M.A.S.L.
